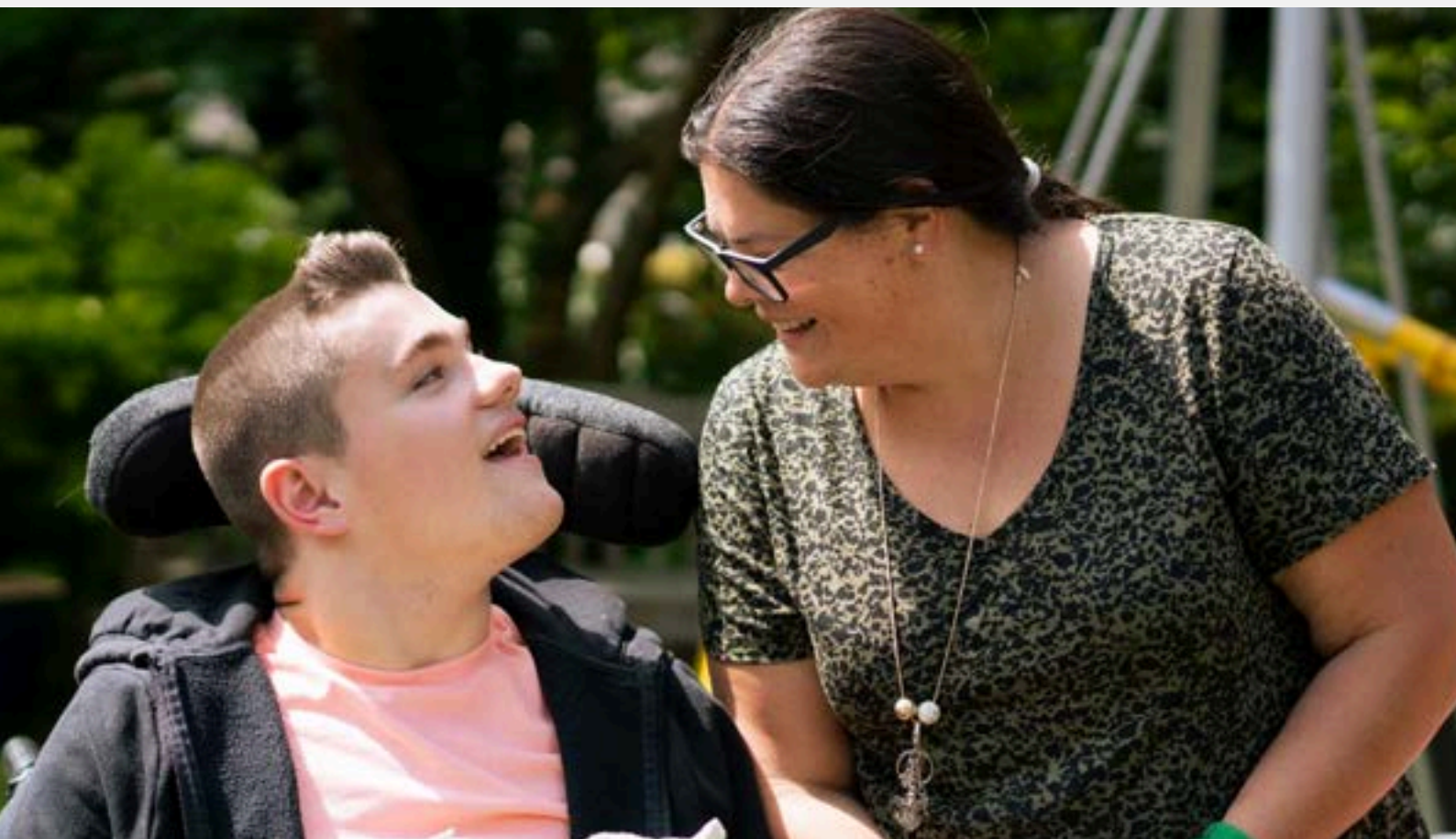

What we offer

Our curriculum aims to enable our learners to develop greater autonomy and engagement with the world around them as they prepare for the next stage in their lives. At Rutherford, students follow a personalised curriculum designed around each young persons goals, strengths and needs. What is important to you is important to us.

Our Students access programmes of study across five holistic, person centred areas. These are; My World, My Wellbeing, My Voice, My Body and My Independence. These areas expand upon the Preparation for Adulthood themes in ways which are meaningful for our young people.

Delivering meaningful outcomes

Our approach to learning is flexible, multisensory, creative and person-centred. Students follow a core programme of sessions designed across the breadth of our curriculum areas and then choose from a range of exciting enrichment options to form their own bespoke timetables.

My Body

With reference to best practice guidelines in ensuring 24hr postural care and an aim to support our young people to engage in physical activity each young person has a program of support designed by physiotherapists and experienced practitioners to meet their physical needs. Alongside this there are opportunities to engage in sports throughout the week and to work towards meaningful functional goals e.g. building core strength for sitting in order to sit at a table in a restaurant or to build skills in independent rolling in order for a young person to have greater opportunities for movement.



My Voice

With a focus on student choice, our young people have opportunities to develop their approaches to communication to make meaningful decisions about how they spend their time and who they spend their time with.

My Independence

We focus on student choice and independent living. Each student will have a bespoke timetable which incorporates the core elements of their holistic support package and ASDAN Life Skills Challenges. We also provide personalised pathways through the use of Assistive Technology.

My Wellbeing

We support the emotional and physical wellbeing for our young people through the use of evidence based strategies and informed by neuroscience. We use strategies which incorporate the senses, nature, creativity, mindfulness, music, touch and building relationships to design a personalised wellbeing programme for each student.



My World

We provide opportunities to engage meaningfully with the world. Young people engage in fun community and cultural celebrations, take part in our popular book club and Sound by Sound sessions and spend time exploring and developing their interests and hobbies.

Therapies and nursing care

At Rutherford we have a trans-disciplinary team who work together to ensure that students' needs are met. Our team of specialised professionals design programmes with practical outcomes to foster independence, learning and achievement for each pupil by meeting individual needs and building on strengths and abilities. Students have bespoke packages of support designed around their goals and aspirations, EHCPs and co-production between our team, the young person and their family.

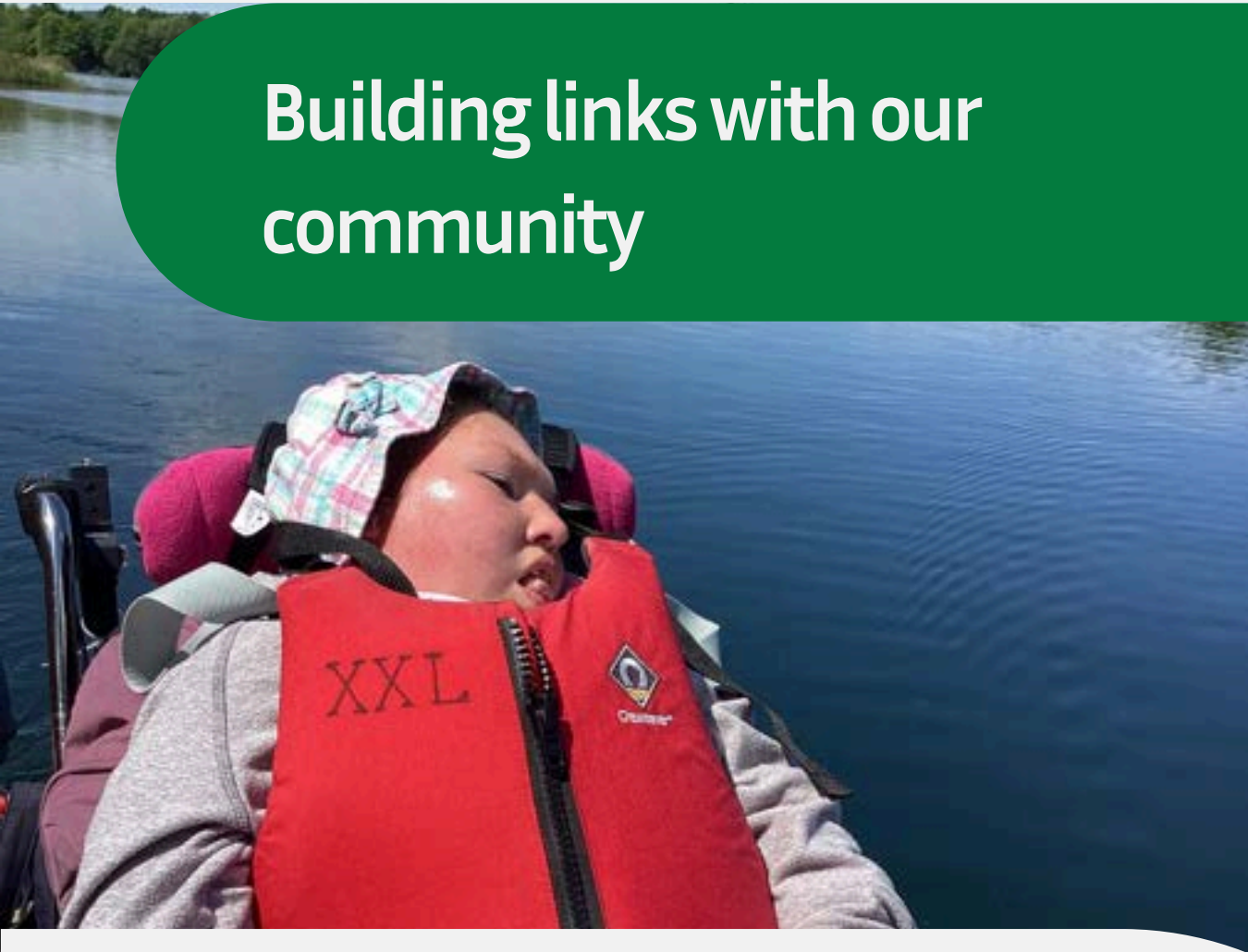

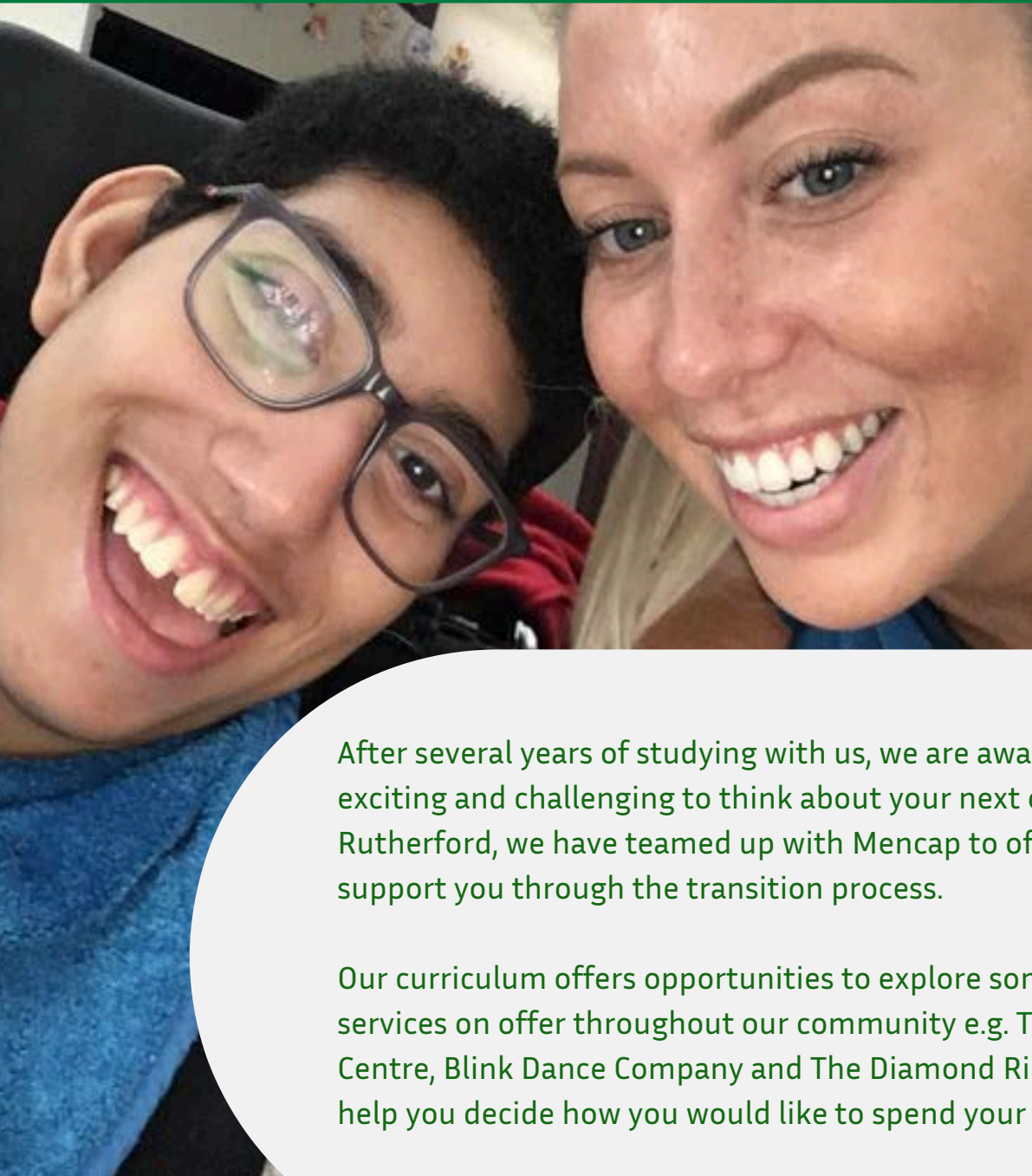
